Harbor Attendance

CREW points. Kickboard is the software
system that all staff are using to award
points based on Harbor's CORE values.

Cooperation, Respect, Excellence, Wise Choices

We recognize positive behavior with daily shout outs! Coming soon..... students will be able to redeem points at a classroom store.

Essentials (*Art, Physical Education*) are working with current cohorts until the November 6th. Major concepts explored:

Body Awareness Working with body parts. Pre-K

Manipulation of objects Overhand throw, Underhand throw. K-2

Manipulation of objects Hockey stick handling and hockey pass/control. 3-5
